Dear Parents / Carers,

This week, I have been delighted to be able to spend a little more time in each of the classrooms, getting to know your children and hearing some of their views on the school. I have been struck by the pride that many of them feel in being a child of Magor CiW Primary School. They talk with excitement about their experiences, what they have achieved previously and what they hope to achieve moving forward.
