**School Update**

In October 2017, I stood in front of the parents of our school as the new Chair of Governors and your parent Governor. During our meeting, I confirmed that the school would be going on a journey of progression and that we would regularly communicate our progress.

This year has seen significant challenges and changes within our school; cumulating in a new head teacher starting in April 2019, the return of Estyn and an updated categorisation from The Education Advisory Service (EAS).

At the time of writing the Governing Body is waiting for the official reports from Estyn and EAS; until these are received our school is unable to share the update; we anticipate both reports being available by the end of January.

I can confirm as we close for Christmas that EAS in association with the Monmouthshire County Council has confirmed that our school has made strong progress against all 8 recommendations contained within the Estyn report.

School will provide a classroom(s) and activities for our children to enable adults to attend the briefing.
