## **Nursery Applications Reminder**

On 8th July 2020, the nursery application process for September 2021 opened for parents/carers to make applications. The closing date is 18th September 2020.

Parents/carers can apply for the September intake and if their child is eligible for a rising 3 place in either January 2021 or April 2021 they can make the request on the same application form.

Parents will be notified by MCC of their nursery place for September 2021 and January 2021 on 2nd November 2020, however, if they have applied for a rising 3 place to start in April 2021 they will be advised on 8th March 2021.
